Today, the University of California at Davis offers a viticulture scholarship in his name for young and up and coming wine makers.

Nathan's influence on Peter and Lesley can't be overstated. He was a frequent diner at the couple's *Fay's Garden Court Café* in Glen Ellen, CA, and a regular visitor to their vineyard in the Sonoma, Carneros region, where they grew Pinot Noir grapes. Over the years, Nathan's spirit has been reflected in the farmers who grow grapes in the Stag's Leap area, and lives on here with us at Graham's Grille today.

Our list offers sophisticated and creative selections that honor highly graded varietals, grape growers, and wine makers. We ensure quality by only offering selections rated at 88 or above on both the Wine Spectator and Robert Parker rating scales, and we complement that by offering affordability in those selections as well.

Mumm Napa Brut Prestige NV **Napa Valley, California**

2010 *Wine Spectator Top 100*

From one of the great French champagne houses, Mumm's California sparkling wine is quite a value at this price and quality. It's bright and tangy, with a core of lemon and lime flavors that fan out on the palate to yield a toasty, fresh finish with hints of apple and pear. Au sante'!

Schramsberg North Coast Brut Rose' 2007 **California**

Schramsberg is a California sparkling wine that has been served in the White House and at American State dinners for decades. A true Methode Champenoise wine, beautiful pink in color, luscious and elegant. A fabulous sparkling wine that will go well with all dishes.

Veuve Clicquot Brut NV **Champagne, France**

The Veuve or "widow" Clicquot is often referred to as the "Grand Dame of Champagne" for her contribution to what we now know as Champagne' or Sparkling wine. In 1805 when her husband passed, she took control of his Champagne' house. Before her takeover, the secondary fermentation, that is still practiced today with the addition of yeasts, left sediment in the bottle and left the wines cloudy and somewhat unappealing. By storing the bottle upside down and freezing the neck (a technique called riddling), Madame Clicquot, was able to remove the sediment and create sparkling wines that were clear, without sediment and more attractive to consumers. Almost all quality sparkling wine production still uses this technique to clarify their wines today. Creamy and lively with green apple and grapefruit flavors. A classic Champagne' for the last 150+ years!

The Segura Viudas Brut Reserva Cava is a blend of the Macabeo, Parellada and Xarel-lo grapes grown in the Penedes region of Spain. This sparkler is fairly crisp with lively floral notes and a mouth-filling creaminess.

Many would be surprised to find out that Rose' wines actually outsell white wines in France. After tasting the 2010 Whispering Angel, you'll begin to understand why. From winemaker Sacha Lichine (a rose' specialist), this rose' from the southern France's Provence region, is an exciting blend of Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah, and Mourvedre. Its floral aromas complement a rich, creamy texture and a long and lively, citrusy finish. Forget any rose' prejudices you might have, this is a serious and well made wine...and seriously delicious.

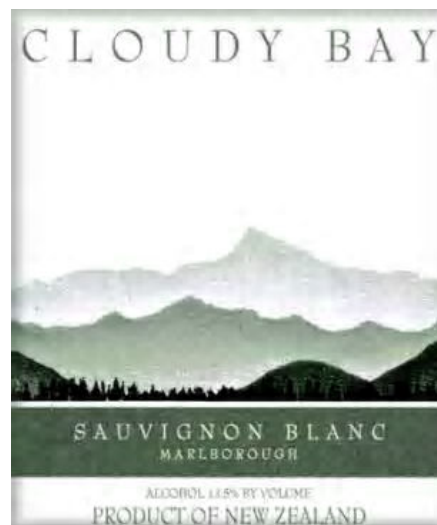

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2011 *New Selection* Marlborough, New Zealand

A Classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc here at Grahams! Widely recognized as New Zealand's quintessential expression of their most popularly grown grape varietal, Cloudy Bay Winery is also credited with putting NZ's Sauvignons on the map back in the late 1980's. The 2011 shows characteristic grassy herbal notes with traces of grapefruit and passion fruit on the palate. Chateau St Jean Fume' Blanc la Petite Etoile 2008 Russian River, Sonoma CA *New Vintage*

The 2008 is another outstanding example of Chateau St Jean's "The Little Star" Fume' Blanc and this vintage also marks California's 30th year in Sauvignon production. The "la Petite Etoile" shows beautiful balance between delicate citrus and honey flavors that go nicely with its well structured minerality and an elegant medium-to-full body. Saint Clair Vicar's Choice Sauvignon Blanc 2011 Marlborough, New Zealand

Our newest vintage of Sauvignon Blanc from Saint Clair, one of Marlborough's key producers since the late 1970s. A classic NZ Sauvignon Blanc, a medium body on the palate with a grassy/herbaceous nose, sharp acidity, and green apple and guava aromas and flavors. (RP 86) 33

Brancott Sauvignon Blanc 2010

Marlborough, New Zealand

Look out for this Sauvignon Blanc produced in New Zealand's premier area for this varietal. Characteristically herbal and grassy with a bright and rich, medium-to-full body. Bright citrus flavors also give the 2010 SB a zippy acidic finish. This selection accentuates characteristics of New Zealand's highly regarded Sauvignons.

New Mexico

A lively, medium bodied Chardonnay with melon aroma's and a fresh, chalky minerality from New Mexico's largest winery.

Central Coast, California

Lean and slightly tart, with pippin apple, sliced pear, apple pie and hints of nectarine. This Chardonnay gains complexity and nuance on the finish, ending with a creamy nutmeg scent. The 2007 Chardonnay Calera Central Coast reveals notes of honeysuckle, orange blossom, and white peaches, medium body, and fine depth as well as purity. This is a vintage for Calera that should age beautifully for 15 or more years, given the winery's history of its top vintages aging brilliantly.

Chehalem Chardonnay INOX 2009

Willamette Valley, Oregon

Don't be fooled by the appearance of this Willamette Valley Chardonnay, you may think it's in fact Sauvignon Blanc. But the truth is that it is created differently than most Chardonnay. Entirely fermented in steel tanks (INOX is from the French word for stainless steel, **inoxydable**), the richness does not come from oak, or malolactic fermentation, but from the Oregon's cool climate which is perfect for the Dijon clones from which it is produced. This lusciously rich chardonnay shows a beautiful bouquet of white fruit, flowers and spice with flavors of vanilla, pear, pineapple and kiwi.

Chalone Chardonnay 2009 *New Vintage*

Central Coast, California

Chalone Chardonnay is back at the top! The wonderful 2009 Chardonnay exhibits a complex mix of layers with subtle pear and mineral flavors. Burgundian in style, look for the typical Chalone full body, and a long, persistent finish. True Chardonnay aficionados will love this wine.

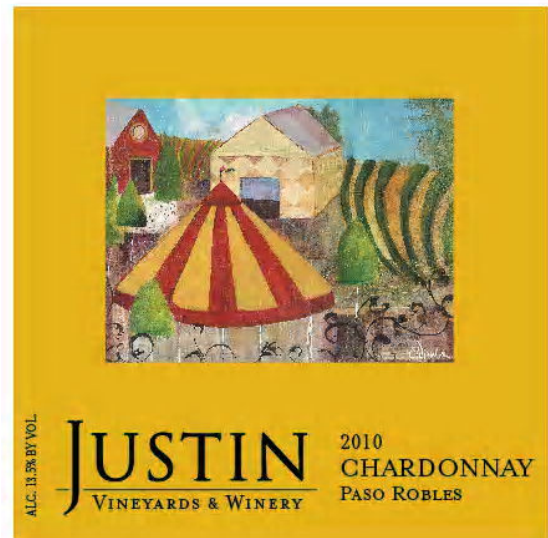

Luca Chardonnay 2008 *New Vintage*

Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina

This is one of the three Luca Catena wines on our Graham's list. The 2008 again spent 12 months in oak, but a little bit less of new French oak, so expect less influence from the barrels and brighter fruit. Unfiltered with Sur lies aging creates a creamier, fuller texture. While the New French oak imparts a subtle amount of spice to go along with its slightly tropical flavors. There's a lingering hint of toasted hazelnut on the rich finish. With a classy, pleasing style, this Chardonnay has arguably been one of the 3-4 best produced in Argentina for a number of years.

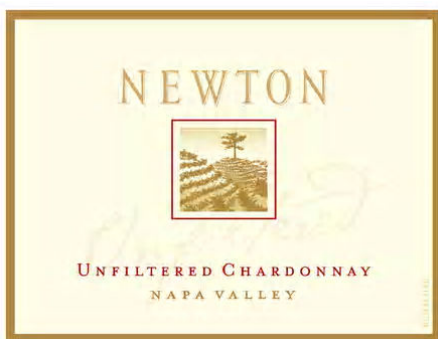


Justin Vineyards Chardonnay 2010

Paso Robles, California

A classic-style California Chardonnay from one of the Central Coast's best producers. Pineapple and tropical fruit scents and flavors. Rich, chewy buttery texture with good intensity and a long finish. Will stand up to and complement foods with complex flavors.

The 2009 Food and Wine Magazine's Winemaker of the Year, Charles Smith has taken his own path to winemaking success. With his unique labeling and self described, "Kick ass attitude" to his winemaking, his approach one of a kind. The 2010 Washington State Riesling shows bright lively apple(strange?), with a zippy acidity that balances its ripe fruit.

This varietal boasts a brilliant yellow straw color, with a highly diverse floral base aroma. Fine notes of fruit such as citrus and green apples and touches of herbs such as basil. Pairs beautifully with our chili rellenos or our other New Mexican dishes too.

Alto Adige, Italy

A great summer wine from grapes grown in northeastern Italy's Alto Adige region is Alois Lageder's Pinot Bianco. Grown in sandy, stony soil in one of Italy's cooler northern climates, this wine has well balanced minerality and round fruity flavors with a nice mouthwatering finish.

Tablas Creek Cote de Tablas Blanc 2008
Paso Robles, California

This is another brilliant effort of the Perrin-Haas partnership. A Rhone blend of Viognier, Marsanne, Roussane and Grenache. Scents of quince, apricot, and white currants. Medium bodied with beautiful density, good acidity, and with a long finish of lingering, fresh, flavors. Good with all foods except the heartiest red meat dishes.

King Estate Pinot Gris 2009
Oregon

This "Certified Organic" Pinot Gris comes from just about 20 miles southwest of Peter Fay's alma matta, the University of Oregon in Eugene, GO DUCKS! Look for delicate floral notes hidden in the glass amongst bright honeysuckle and tangerine aromas. Its medium-to-full body balances a lively citric acidity with good mineral presence. Lime, green apple, and honeysuckle flavors precede a smooth, lingering finish. A fun and refreshing selection.

Orange, France

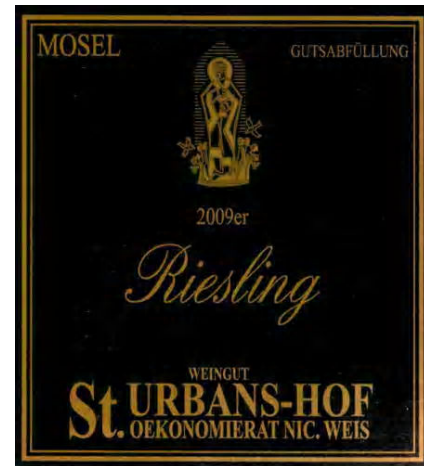
Elk Cove Pinot Gris 2009
Willamette Valley, Oregon

2010 *Wine Spectator* Top 100

This 2009 Pinot Gris comes from one of the first wineries in Oregon's famous Willamette Valley, Elk Cove Vineyards. For over 35 years, the Campbell family has focused on the delicate Pinot Gris and Pinot Noir varietals that flourish in the cool climates of the Willamette Valley. The 2009 Pinot Gris has a crisp and rich mouthfeel followed by juicy white fruit and citrus flavors. This refreshing wine can be enjoyed with almost all dishes with the exception of heavier red meat dishes.

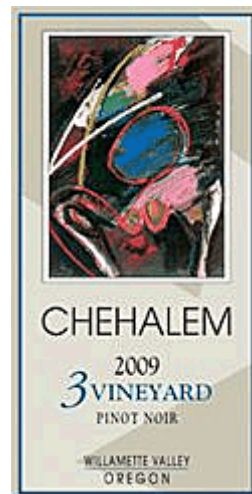

Willamette Valley, Oregon

Our second "Burgundian" varietal from Chehalem, the 2009 Pinot Noir shows dark, but lively red fruit, hints of orange peel, and a touch of nutmeg, cardamom, and black pepper. Supple on the palate with a persistent and focused finish.

This one of the two Domaine Serene Pinots we have on our list. Smooth and luscious, the 2007 Evanstad Reserve is a blend of over 70 lots. Medium ruby-colored, it offers notes of cedar, cinnamon, clove, cassis, and raspberry. This is followed by a medium- to full-bodied wine with layers of complex red fruits, enough structure to evolve for 3-4 years, excellent integration of oak, tannin, and acidity, and a lengthy finish.

From the A to Z Wineworks winery whose slogan is "Aristocratic wines at Democratic Prices." Look for a perfectly balanced rich mouth feel, that opens up to bright red and black fruit flavors. Beaux Freres Pinot Noirs

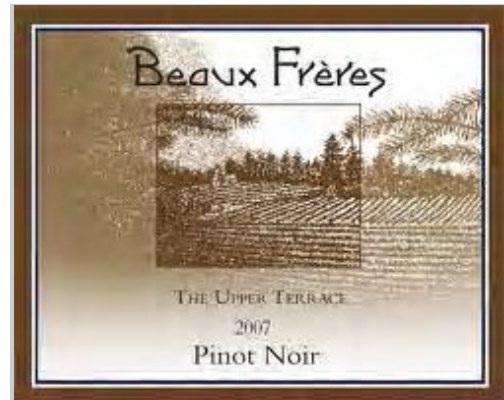
Beaux Freres is a very interesting story. This is a superb maker of three outstanding Oregon Pinot Noirs, all of which are made in the Cote du Beaune style. An interesting fact is that one of the winery's owners is Robert Parker. Parker, as a matter of policy, does not conduct or permit any tastings to rate these wines for his publication, as he (correctly!) believes it would be a conflict that would affect his credibility. However, Wine Spectator does taste, and rate these wines, all of them highly. Graham's Grille is extremely proud to offer all three of these prestigious wines.

Beaux Freres Pinot Noir Willamette Valley 2008
Willamette Valley, Oregon

The Willamette Valley cuvee, formerly known as Belle Soeurs, is light, silky and inviting, with a gossamer texture letting the delicate blueberry, cherry and nutmeg flavors slip easily through the long, enticing finish. This delicious wine is a crowd pleaser, and will be a lush and supple partner to help the enjoyment of a wide variety of our meat, chicken and fish dishes.

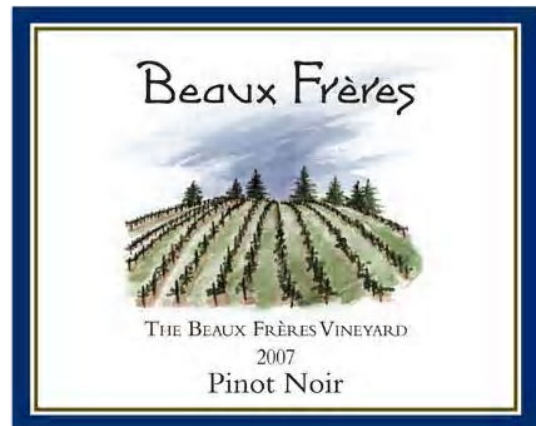
Beaux Freres Pinot Noir Ribbon Ridge
The Upper Terrace 2007

Willamette Valley, Oregon

The 2007 Beaux Freres Upper Terrace is from 100% Dijon Clones, and is the most fuller style of all the Beaux Freres wines. Darker, but still light and silky, this is bright with dark black cherry, raspberry and pomegranate, showing a hint of lime as the finish takes off with grace and beautiful focus. The tannins are totally submerged, but the weight of the wine is quite dramatic.

Willamette Valley, Oregon

The Beaux Freres Vineyard is from fruit grown on the original estate vineyard, one of the two wines grown on the original site, which is now part of the prestigious, designated Ribbon Ridge AVA. This Pinot Noir is primarily from Pommard clones, and is light and fragrant, with a silky core of raspberry and strawberry fruit, shaded with loamy earth and green olive notes. Again, as with all of the Beaux Freres wines, this will be an elegant partner to help the enjoyment of a wide variety of meat, chicken and fish dishes.

Concha Y Toro Cabernet Sauvignon Marques De Casa Concha 2008

Puente Alto, Chile

Finding an affordable, perfectly aged Cabernet can often be a task, but in the 2008 Marques de Casa Concha you will find both. Just coming of age, its smoky, blackberry aromas compliment its plush, succulent body. Licorice and coffee flavors balance with lively black fruit and ripe tannins. The 2008 Cabernet Sauvignon Marques de Casa Concha spent 18 months in one, two and three year old French oak barrels. Alluring aromas of cedar, lavender, blackcurrant and blackberry are followed by a plush, layered, succulent wine with gobs of black fruit, and finely grained tannins. A smooth, well balanced, and tasteful wine. One of the World's great values in high quality Cabernet is produced by Chile's largest winery. Enjoy it now, because this Cab won't be around for long.

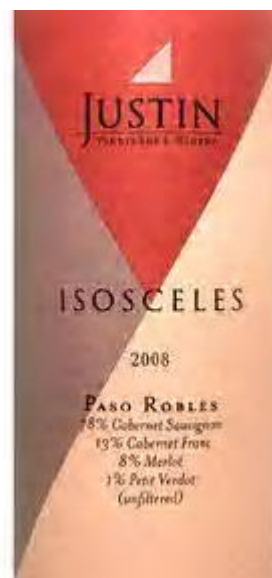


Crios de Susana Balbo Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 **Mendoza, Argentina**

This 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon spent 9 months in one-year-old French and American oak and was bottled without fining or filtration. Purple-colored, it reveals an expressive perfume of cedar, spice box, black currant and black raspberry. This is followed by a medium to full-bodied wine with lots of savory black fruit, with good structure and a long, fruit-filled finish.

Paso Robles, California

This iconic left-bank style Bordeaux blend has been a 20 year project for winemakers Justin and Deborah Baldwin and has become a staple wine in the Paso Robles region. Look for aromas of raspberry, vanilla, and subtle coffee notes. With 24 months of barrel aging in French Oak, this wine is big, firm, and juicy with clean dark fruit flavors and a slightly spiced finish. This wine is coming to us just in time for winter!

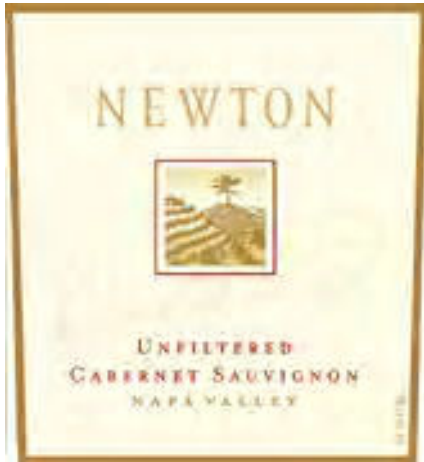

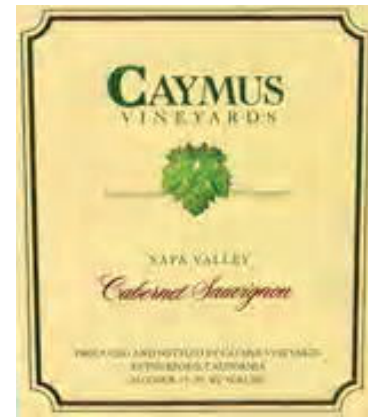

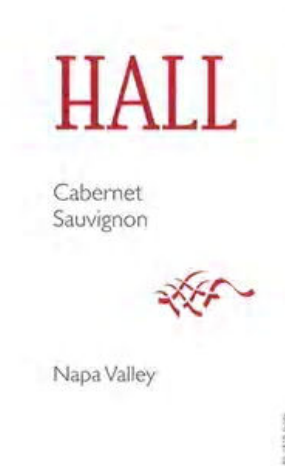

2007 Stag's Leap Vineyards "Fay" Cabernet Sauvignon

The Graham's Grille and Fay family wine history dates back to 1954 when cousin Nathan Fay is credited with planting the first Cabernet Sauvignon grapes in one of the world's locations best known for the varietal, Napa Valley, California. At the time, the US was not known for its wine production, nor the Napa Valley for its Cabernet Sauvignon, but through Nathan's work, that was all about to change.

Nathan's approach as a winemaker was very much that of a student and a teacher. He planted his Cabernet vines in various location in his 400+ acre vineyard and tested and studied the variance of the soil in each of the locations. He selflessly shared his learnings with many of the first winemakers in the Napa Valley. Most notable being Warren Winiarski of the Stag's Leap Wine Cellars.

In 1968, Winiarski first tasted a batch of Nathan's small batch homemade Cabernet Sauvignon, and immediately fell in love. "Eureka! That's it. This wine satisfied what I hoped was possible in the Napa Valley". In 1970 he purchased a 44 acre lot adjacent to Nathan's Stag's Leap vineyard and he continued to learn and grow from Nathan and perfect the wine they both knew could put the Napa Valley on the map. And that's exactly what they did.

With Nathan always next door, Winiarski produced his first vintage in 1972, and in 1973, he produced his first batch in commercial quantities. The 73' vintage was entered into the 1976 "Judgement of Paris" and put up against France's top wines and winemakers. It was also judged by the most recognized tasters in France at the time. Most of whom dismissed the idea of quality wine being made anywhere outside of France and Europe. It was a blind tasting.

The 1973 Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon was tasted against the best Bordeaux offerings that included first growth Chateau Haut-Brion and Chateau Mouton-Rothschild, some of Bordeaux's most cherished and deeply rooted winemaking houses. When the tasting was complete, the Napa Valley and California wines would forever have their place in the wine world. Winiarski's Cabernet rated the highest of all red selections at the tasting. The tasting was called

by many a "vinous shot heard round the world". A shot that started with Nathan's vision 22 years earlier.

In his time he continued to grow grapes and sell his fruit to some of Napa's most notable producers including Peter and Robert Mondavi, Joseph Phelps, John Kongsgaard, Doug Fletcher, and Joseph Heitz to name a few. He grew grapes until his retirement in 1986 when he sold his estate to his neighbor, Winiarski.

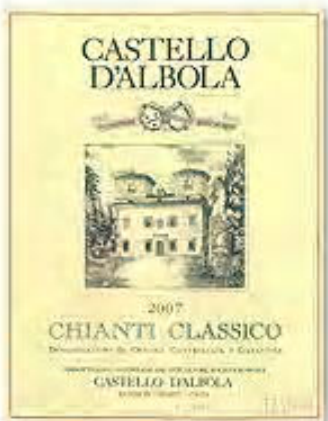
In May of 2000, Fay was honored at the historic Stag's Leap Estate by many of Napa's great winemakers, many of whom credit their success to Nathan's early work. On the same afternoon, Nathan was able to witness of the first presentation of the "Nathan Fay Graduate Fellowship Fund". An annual \$10,000 check from the Stag's Leap District Winegrowers, to the UC Davis Viticulture and Enology Department, for up and coming winemakers in his name.

Nathan passed in February 2001, but in his last years, was a frequent guest of the Peter and Lesley's Garden Court Café in Sonoma. Peter and Lesley often speak of his kind demeanor and selflessness, and of the visits to his Stag's Leap estate where they were given the opportunity to see and experience first hand his lifelong passion for growing grapes and making wine.

In Nathan's memory, we are proud to offer the Stag's Leap Vineyard's 2007 "Fay" Cabernet Sauvignon, made from grapes planted and grown on Nathan's original vineyard.
